**MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF OBJECTION OF
THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO
DOCUMENT REQUESTS OF CAPITAL ONE SERVICES, INC.
(COS/USPS-DR-1-17)

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its objection to Document Requests COS/USPS-DR-1-17, which were filed by Capital One Services, Inc. on August 8, 2008, and due on August 18, 2008. The Postal Service's objection was prepared and submitted for filing yesterday afternoon in advance of the 4:30pm filing deadline. At the request of the Commission's Docket Section, however, the filing was postponed to change the title to reflect its status as objections to a request for documents, as opposed to objections to interrogatories. The delay caused by the revision resulted in missing the 4:30 deadline by a few minutes. Accordingly, the Postal Service moves for late acceptance of its objection, one day out of time. The Postal Service does not believe that any party will be prejudiced by this brief delay.
