MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR
LATE ACCEPTANCE OF FILING OF INSTITUTIONAL RESPONSE TO
MAJOR MAILERS ASSOCIATION INTERROGATORY (MMA/USPS-T32-7(B))

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of the filing of its institutional response to the following interrogatory of Major Mailers Association: MMA/USPS-T32-7(B). The response was redirected from witness Taufique to the Postal Service for response. The response was due to have been filed on July 12, 2006 -- 12 calendar days ago. The responsibility of preparing another testimony for filing in this docket on July 14th (USPS-T-48) prevented witness Taufique from giving related interrogatories his undivided attention, which in turn, delayed the preparation of the institutional response to MMA/USPS-T32-7(B). The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that any prejudice to the parties is minimal.
