PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING  
GRANTING CONSENT MOTIONS FOR EXTENSIONS OF TIME

(Issued September 16, 2008)

On September 12, 2008, Capital One Services, Inc. (Capital One) filed two motions for extensions of time to file motions to compel.<sup>1</sup> Capital One explains that it is in discussions with the Postal Service in an effort to address discovery disputes informally. The Postal Service consents to extending the time for submitting motions to compel while discussions are ongoing. Capital One commits to keeping the Commission apprised of the progress of these discussions.

It is most efficient and effective if parties can resolve discovery disputes informally. Therefore, the motions will be granted.

RULING

1. The Consent Motion for an Extension of Time to File Motions to Compel for Document Requests COS/USPS-DR-1-17, 19-22, filed September 12, 2008, is granted.
