PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVE MOTION FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME FOR RESPONSE TO OBJECTION OF  
UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE

On September 15, 2008, the United States Postal Service filed an objection to Public Representative interrogatory, PR/USPS-15, submitted September 3, 2008. The Postal Service objects to the above-referenced interrogatory on grounds of relevance, and that the requested analyses are protected from disclosure under 39 U.S.C. § 410(c)(4). Under Commission rules, a response to the Postal Service's objection is due September 22, 2008.

The Public Representative hereby requests an extension of time of three days to provide its response to the objection of the Postal Service. The Public Representative is necessarily away from the office until Monday, September 22, 2008. As a consequence, the Public Representative is not able to prepare a full response to the Postal Service's stated grounds for objection. A three day extension of time, until September 24, 2008, should not burden any party as discovery is ongoing pending the establishment of a procedural schedule. Postal Service counsel has no objection to the Public Representative's request for a three day extension of time.
