The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice of an error in the cover page transmitting its filing of responses to the following interrogatories of the Office of the Consumer Advocate on June 1, 2006: OCA/USPS-35 through 38 and 41 through 43. The caption and the body of the notice filed that day incorrectly identify the responses to OCA/USPS-39 and 40 as having been included in that set, creating the impression that the set ranged from OCA/USPS-35 to 43. As indicated in another pleading today, the responses to OCA/USPS-39 and 40 were inadvertently omitted. The Postal Service regrets the oversight and any confusion it may have caused.
