The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its filing of the responses of witness Altaf H. Taufique to the following interrogatories of Major Mailers Association: MMA/USPS-T32-1 through 3(A), 4 through 7(A) and 7(C-D). The responses were due to have been filed on July 12, 2006 -- 12 calendar days ago.
