UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE NOTICE OF ERRATA REGARDING
USPS LIBRARY REFERENCE L-193 [ERRATA]
(December 13, 2006)

The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is filing revised copies of the electronic version of USPS Library Reference L-193 with the Commission today. The electronic files should replace the files that were filed on November 20, 2006. The changes are as follows:

Text Files in LR-L-193

Alldata2 – duplicate records have been eliminated
Alldata2-xls – Excel version of alldata2 included
All output files from Fortran programs changed
PC Fortran of programs included

The changes are necessary because in reviewing the input data, six instances of duplicate entries were discovered. Five of the duplicate records were the result of the field sending revisions to data collection forms that they had previously submitted, and they were mistakenly entered as separate observations rather than revisions. The sixth duplicate record arose because one form was submitted by both the site coordinator and the field office. These

duplicate records contained a slight revision in one portion of the form, and thus were not detected by the software used to identify duplicates.

In addition, an Excel file of the "alldata2" file has been included with the revised version of USPS-LR-L-193 being filed today.
