
Pursuant to Order No. 1115 of the Postal Rate Commission issued June 12, 1996, which requested participants in this Docket to file a notice of issues they would like to raise for consideration at the prehearing conference on July 12, 1996, Nashua Photo Inc. ("Nashua") and Mystic Color Lab ("Mystic"), both full intervenors in these proceedings, hereby submit the following:

Notice of Issues to be Raised

1. Whether the Postal Rate Commission should expand the scope of the current Docket to consider a proposed modification of Business Reply Mail ("BRM"), which is not included in the Postal Service's Request for Recommended Decision?
2. Whether the relevant data support the establishment of a discount, comparable to the BRMAS discount, for certain non-automatable bulk business reply mail?
3. Whether the Postal Reorganization Act, specifically 39 U.S.C. section 403(c), permits limiting the eligibility for BRMAS-type discounts to automatable mail when comparable savings are achieved by non-automatable bulk business reply mail?




