PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING ALLOWING FOR
LATE FILING OF INTERROGATORIES

(August 19, 1996)

On August 13, 1996 Nashua Photo Inc. and Mystic Color Lab requested permission to file discovery one day late. The Postal Service has indicated it has no objection to this request. Therefore, it will be granted.

The American Bankers Association and the American Postal Workers Union submitted discovery requests which were received at the Commission Docket Room slightly after the close of business on the last day for filing discovery.
