PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING GRANTING  
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

(September 5, 1996)

The OCA filed interrogatories OCA/USPS-48-56 on August 22, 1996. On September 3, 1996, the Postal Service filed objections to interrogatories 48, 53(b) and (c), 56(c) and partial objections to 54(b) and (e). On September 4, 1996, the Postal Service filed a request for a one day extension of time to file responses to the remaining interrogatories in this set. Counsel for the Postal Service states that OCA has no objection to the requested extension. These circumstances warrant granting of the Postal Service's motion.

RULING

The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Extension of Time to Respond to OCA/USPS-48 through 56 is granted as described in this ruling.
