
PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING GRANTING  
UNOPPOSED MOTION OF STAMPS.COM  
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER  
POSTAL SERVICE MOTION TO COMPEL

(Issued June 30, 2000)

On June 29, 2000 intervenor Stamps.com filed a request for an extension of time to answer a Postal Service motion to compel a response to Interrogatory UPSP/STAMPS.COM-T3-1, filed on June 23. Counsel represents that in the press of preparing other documents for this proceeding he did not become aware of the Service's motion until June 26, and requests an extension until July 5, 2000. Counsel further represents that Postal Service counsel has been informed of this request, and has stated that the Service has no objection to the proposed extension. In view of the circumstances cited by movant, I shall grant the requested extension until July 5.

RULING

The Motion of Stamps.com for Extension of Time to Answer USPS's Motion to Compel (USPS/STAMPS.COM-T3-1), filed June 29, 2000, is granted.
