DBP/USPS-88 This interrogatory attempts to determine the extent to which the 17 outlier facilities are able to meet both the requirements of the Postal Operations Manual to ensure that mail which should be entered into the system on Day 0 [subparts a, b, d, and e] will in fact be so as well as the ability to mesh with their parent P&DC's requirements [subparts c and f].

This is relevant to evaluating the service standards for mail originating at an outlier facility.

For the reasons given, the Postal Service should be compelled to provide the answers to this interrogatory that has been objected to.
