

PRC LR-3: Base Year Costs

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This library reference presents the B workpapers used to calculate base year costs developed with the attributable cost principles adopted by the Commission in Docket No. R2000-1. These B workpapers are the ones submitted by the Postal Service in USPS LR-J-74, PRC Version/Base Year Model, with corrections made in the worksheets for Segment 6 & 7, City Carrier Costs.

1. LR-J-74, Cost Segment 6 & 7, Worksheet 7.0.4.1, lines 36 through 42, contains Curblin Access Test (CAT)/Foot Access Test (FAT) factors which, when multiplied by the accrued runtime yield access costs. In response to POIR No. 5, question 5, the Postal Service confirmed that the CAT/FAT factors presented in LR-J-74 were incorrect. If provided corrected factors that reflect the Commission's R2000-1 cost attribution principles. They are based on City Carrier Cost System data for BY 2000. See, the Postal Service's response to POIR No. 5, question 5. Tr. 11B/4337-38.
2. The Commission also revises the Load Time Factor variabilities presented by the Postal Service in LR-J-74, Cost Segment 6 & 7, Worksheet 7.0.4.2, lines 8 through 12, to be consistent with the values used by the Commission in Docket No. R2001-1, in PRC LR-6. Although the Load Time Factor variabilities should have been updated to reflect FY 2000 CCS data, those numbers were not submitted in this docket. Future submissions should update all factors dependent on the City Carrier Cost System.

The changes made in the Segment 6 & 7 worksheets ripple through to require adjustments in the worksheets presenting the indirect cost associated with City Carriers, These indirect costs are contained in Segments 2, 12, 13 and 20. The following hard copy worksheets contain the changes in the Segment 2, 6 & 7, 12, 13 and 20 worksheets.

Electronic copies of the all the worksheets from LR-J-74, as corrected, are contained in the attached CD. The files are either input data files or base year cost calculations organized by cost segment. The workbook files are:
