MOTION FOR CONSIDERATION OF STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT
(June 21, 2002)

The United States Postal Service hereby submits a Stipulation and Agreement (Agreement), representing a negotiated settlement by the parties (hereinafter, the “settlement parties”) of all issues raised in this proceeding. The settlement parties request that the Postal Rate Commission issue an opinion and recommended decision which is based upon the evidentiary record developed in this proceeding and which incorporates the Domestic Mail Classification Schedule and Fee Schedule changes requested by the Postal Service in this proceeding, which is appended to the Agreement.

A total of 5 parties have signed the Agreement.¹ The remaining party, David B. Popkin, has indicated that he does not oppose settlement. Presently, the Postal Service is in possession of fax signature pages from 3 of the 5 parties, which is appended to the Agreement. Counsel for APWU and Douglas Carlson have indicated that original signature pages have been sent by First-Class Mail. Once received, those documents will be filed with the Commission.
