RULING ON CARLSON MOTION RELATING TO  
DESIGNATED CROSS-EXAMINATION AND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(Issued February 18, 2004)

The complainant, in Douglas F. Carlson Motion to Postpone Deadline for Designating Written Cross-Examination to the Postal Service, February 3, 2004, indicates that he interprets an earlier ruling (P.O. Ruling No. C2001-3/39) as requiring him to file designations by February 6, 2004. He seeks an extension to February 17, 2004 or later. The motion is granted, with the deadline for filing all designations of responses to written discovery directed to the Postal Service prior to the submission of complainant's testimony set for February 27, 2004.

RULING
