The United States Postal Service hereby gives notice that it is filing today the following Category 2 library reference:

USPS-LR-1 Opinion Research Corporation: "Repositionable Notes (RPN) Concept Research Report" (May 2004)

Pursuant to Rule 32(b)(2)(iv), this material is being filed as a library reference because: (1) it is a secondary source that provides background to witness Holland's testimony, and (2) reference to, identification of, and use of the material will be facilitated by filing it as a library reference. Rule 32(b)(2)(ii)(B) and (C).

This is a Category 2 (Witness Foundational Materials) library reference because it consists of materials relating to the testimony of witness Holland (USPS-T-1) and it establishes a proper foundation for receiving into evidence his analysis of the market for Repositionable Notes (RPNs). The library reference describes the qualitative research conducted by the Opinion Research Corporation on behalf of the Postal Service. It is divided into four sections, in addition to an Executive Summary, and has one appendix. Section I contains an Introduction to the research, section II describes the focus groups consisting of small and medium businesses, section III describes the focus groups consisting of consumers, and section IV describes in-depth interviews with larger businesses.

This material relates to issues in the proceeding because it supports witness Holland's testimony regarding the market for RPNs. The research was conducted and

the report was produced by the Opinion Research Corporation. The documents to which the library reference relates are witness Holland's and witness Kaneer's testimonies. The library reference is not an update or a revision of another library reference. Finally, the entire library reference is expected to become record evidence sponsored by witness Holland.

Copies of this library reference are also on file with the Postal Service library.
