SECOND REPORT ON THE STATUS OF NEGOTIATIONS
FOR INFORMAL RESOLUTION OF COMPLAINT
(August 12, 2004)

By Order of August 10, 2004, the Commission granted the Office of the Consumer Advocate, as settlement coordinator, until no later than August 20, 2004 to report on the progress of informal settlement negotiations between the Complainant and the Postal Service.¹ The parties have now indicated that based upon their respective positions, as discussed in the previous conference call between the parties on July 15, 2004, there is no possibility for settlement at this time and the parties are prepared to move forward with the normal course of the proceeding.
