PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING ON SCHEDULING MATTERS

(Issued September 15, 2004)

Pursuant to a previous ruling, testimony responding to the Complaint of Time Warner Inc. et al. has been filed, written discovery is underway, and the period of October 19-22, 2004 (Tuesday through Friday) has been reserved for hearings, if needed. See P.O. Ruling No. 2004-1/3, June 18, 2004.

In the event formal hearings are held on this testimony, participants are asked to confirm, no later than September 30, 2004, witness availability during this period and to indicate preferences, if any, as to dates of appearance. Participants are also asked to indicate no later than October 7, 2004 whether or not they wish to orally cross-examine any witnesses, to state with specificity which witness (or witnesses) they wish to cross-examine and, to the extent possible, to indicate whether such cross-examination is anticipated to be light, moderate or extensive.

RULING

1. Statements confirming witness availability during the period October 19-22, 2004 and preferences, if any, as to dates of appearance are due no later than September 30, 2004.
2. Statements indicating whether or not oral cross-examination is requested, identifying the witness or witnesses involved, and providing an assessment of the anticipated amount of oral cross-examination (on the terms stated in the body of this ruling) are due no later than October 7, 2004.
