Presiding Officer's Information Request No. 2, issued on September 23, requested a status report on the Postal Service's efforts to produce the information requested in items 2 and 3. It appears that the Postal Service will be able to conduct the exercise as requested. The hope would be that everything for all three items could be completed within the timeframe of the original request (two weeks). If it turns out that completion of responses to items 2 and 3 lags behind, one additional week would probably be sufficient, barring any as yet unforeseen circumstances.
