PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
GRANTING AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION,
AFL-CIO MOTION

(Issued June 21, 2005)

The American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO, has requested authority to submit written interrogatories to Postal Service witness Van-Ty-Smith one business day late. The deadline for discovery addressed to witness Van-Ty-Smith was Friday, June 17, 2005. The motion indicates that four discovery requests had been prepared on that date, but were inadvertently not submitted in a timely fashion. Allowing this request should not seriously add to the burden on this witness, and the motion will be granted.
