PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING  
GRANTING MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE

(Issued July 18, 2005)

A Motion of the United States Postal Service for Late Acceptance of the Objection of the United States Postal Service to Interrogatory DBP/USPS-198 was filed July 14, 2005. The motion will be granted. The interrogatory in question is one of an exceptionally large number of detailed follow-up questions posed just before and during the period when oral cross-examination of Postal Service witnesses was in progress. Under the circumstances, the delay is understandable and unlikely to seriously inconvenience either Mr. Popkin or any other participant.
