PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
ADMITTING MAJOR MAILERS ASSOCIATION
SUPPLEMENTAL DESIGNATION

(Issued July 29, 2005)

Presiding Officer's Ruling No. 41 established a date of July 19, 2005 as the deadline for designating as part of the evidentiary record responses to questions posed during hearings on the Postal Service's case-in-chief. On July 18, 2005, Major Mailers Association (MMA) filed a Motion to Supplement Designation of One Institutional Response as Written Cross-Examination (Motion). The Motion requested that a 57-page printout of Excel File MMA-USPS-T-21-26_-_FCM_Million.xls, which was included as part of the Postal Service's May 20, 2005 institutional response to interrogatory MMA/USPS-T21-26, be included as part of the evidentiary record. MMA's Motion was followed on July 22 by a Motion for Leave to File Out-of-Time Additional Materials for Inclusion in the Evidentiary Record (Motion for Leave to File Out-of-Time).

No party will be prejudiced by granting these motions. Thus, the Motion and Motion for Leave to File Out-of-Time are granted, and the designated written cross-examination, consisting of the 57-page printout of Excel File MMA-USPS-T-21-26_-_FCM_Million.xls, shall be included in the record of this proceeding.

RULING

1. Major Mailers Association's Motion to Supplement Designation of One Institutional Response as Written Cross-Examination, filed July 18, 2005, is granted.

2. The Motion of Major Mailers Association for Leave to File Out-of-Time Additional Materials for Inclusion in the Evidentiary Record, filed July 22, 2005, is granted.
