PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
OPENING AND RECLOSING THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD

The Office of the Consumer Advocate has filed a request to reopen the evidentiary record for the purpose of incorporating written cross-examination questions received after the close of the record.¹
