DFC/USPS-52. Please refer to the response to OCA/USPS-27(a). Please explain whether the Postal Service Board of Governors has approved the Postal Service’s proposal to prohibit customers from using postage stamps to pay the postage for items mailed at the rate for single-piece Bound Printed Matter.

DFC/USPS-53. Please refer to the response to OCA/USPS-27(a). Please provide the number of postage meters that currently are licensed to mailers.

DFC/USPS-54. Please refer to the response to OCA/USPS-27(d). Please provide the minimum number of pieces required to send mail at a Periodicals rate and to send mail at a Standard Mail rate.
