PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
GRANTING POSTAL SERVICE MOTION TO INCLUDE
REVISED INTERROGATORY RESPONSES IN THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD

(Issued October 12, 2006)

The Postal Service has filed a motion requesting that its original responses to interrogatories DBP/USPS-340 and 341 be stricken from the evidentiary record, and that its revised responses be included in the next transcript volume of designated institutional Postal Service interrogatory responses.¹ The original responses were filed on August 7, 2006, and appear in the evidentiary record at Tr. 18C/5975-76. The revised responses were filed on October 10, 2006.²

The motion is granted. The revised responses to DBP/USPS-340 and 341 shall be designated as revised/substituted responses and included in the next transcript volume of designated Postal Service responses. The original responses appearing at Tr. 18C/5975-76 shall be treated as stricken from the record.
