PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING
CERTIFYING COALITION OF CATALOG MAILERS' MOTION FOR
LATE INTERVENTION TO THE FULL COMMISSION

(Issued April 27, 2007)

On April 3, 2007, a group of mailers, the Coalition of Catalog Mailers (CCM), filed a Notice of Intervention in this case.¹ Pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice and Procedure 20(c), CCM concurrently filed a motion for late acceptance of its Notice of Intervention.² Valpak Direct Marketing Systems, Inc. and Valpak Dealers' Association, Inc. (Valpak) oppose CCM's Motion for late intervention.³

The arguments in CCM's Motion and Valpak's Opposition raise important due process and other significant legal issues that may affect the outcome of this proceeding. Therefore, pursuant to Commission rule 23(a)(8), I certify this motion to the full Commission for its consideration and disposition.
