NOTICE OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE  
OF FILING AMENDED NOTICE OF  
MARKET-DOMINANT PRICE ADJUSTMENT  
(March 26, 2008)

In accordance with section 3010.13(e), the Postal Service is hereby filing an amended notice of its Market-Dominant Price Adjustment. In response to the Commission's Review of Postal Service Notice of Market Dominant Price Adjustment, Order No. 66, Docket No. R2008-1 (March 17, 2008), the Postal Service is thus revising its original Notice of Market-Dominant Price Adjustment, which was filed on February 11, 2008. The Postal Service thanks the Commission for its efforts in expeditiously reviewing the Postal Service's first market-dominant price adjustment under the Postal Accountability and Enhancement Act. The only revisions being made today are intended to alter the prices associated with the pre-barcoded discount for Standard Mail mixed AADC letters. In light of the Commission's determination and suggested approach in Order No. 66, the Postal Service has concluded that the following adjustments would be consistent with applicable statutory standards.

In PRC-LR-3, workbook “CAPCALC-STD-FY2008.xls”, four changes should be made, all in worksheet (tab) “L-F-P New Prices.” The values in four cells should be changed as follows:

<u>Cell</u>	<u>Change</u>
E17	from 0.271 to 0.260
F17	from 0.238 to 0.227
E81	from 0.173 to 0.162
F81	from 0.140 to 0.129

These changes reduce the class average increase shown on worksheet “Price Change Summary” from 2.875 percent to 2.838 percent, and increase the unused rate change authority from 0.025 percent to 0.062 percent. None of the revisions being made today result in the Postal Service piercing the price cap. A revised page 10 of Appendix A is attached to this Notice, which reflects the Postal Service’s Standard Mail price adjustments. As noted above, the revisions are limited to the Mixed-AADC/ADC, Machinable Origin and DBMC prices, in both Commercial and Nonprofit. All four of these prices are 1.1 cents lower than those in the Notice filed February 11, 2008. None of the other price adjustments included in the February 11, 2008 Notice are affected by these amendments.

Finally, the Postal Service will provide notice to its customers of these changes

through various communication channels, including the *DMM Advisory* and *P&C Weekly*.

Add \$0.015 for each piece bearing a Repositionable Note.

Forward and Return Service - If used in conjunction with electronic or automated Address Correction Service, forwarded letters pay \$0.35 per piece and returned letters pay the applicable First-Class Mail price. All other letters requesting Forwarding-and-Return Service that are returned are charged the appropriate First-Class Mail price for the piece plus the price multiplied by a factor of 2.472.

Pieces that weigh more than 3.3 ounces but not more than 3.5 ounces pay the flats piece and pound rate but receive a discount off the piece rate equal to the minimum flats per piece rate minus the minimum letter per piece rate corresponding to the applicable entry and density tier.
