PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING  
GRANTING EXTENSION

(Issued May 6, 2009)

A Motion of the United States Postal Service for Extension of Deadlines Pursuant to Order No. 208, was filed May 5, 2009 (Motion). The Motion states that knowledgeable Postal Service counsel was on unscheduled leave that day, and as a result, the Postal Service was unexpectedly unable to make an appropriate filing.

The Postal Service requests the schedule set forth in Order No. 208 be extended accordingly. The Motion is granted.

Filings due May 5, 2009 may be submitted on May 6, 2009. If knowledgeable counsel remain unavailable, the Postal Service shall accompany any additional requests for delay with an estimate of when adequate resources can be assigned to these matters.

Finally, the Postal Service requests that it be permitted to file a status update describing its efforts to comply with Order No. 208 when the aforementioned counsel returns to the office. The Postal Service should do so. Such an update will help the Commission evaluate appropriate action should further procedural relief be requested.

RULING

The Motion of the United States Postal Service for Extension of Deadlines Pursuant to Order No. 208, filed May 5, 2009, is granted, as described in the body of this ruling.
