**GFL/USPS-214.** Please refer to your response to GFL/USPS-207(a), which states:

Confirmed, although the calculations are slightly more precise using the 'linked' version of the model, CD Outbound.xls, rather than the 'unlinked' version of the model, CD Outbound v.xls" and the cost models in Cost\_Model.zip.

Please list all differences between the "linked" and "unlinked" versions of the cost models in Cost\_Model.zip that could cause the costs in the "linked" versions of the models to be more precise or accurate than those in the "unlinked" versions.

**RESPONSE:**

Any cell that references both an internal cell and an external workbook would be more precise in the 'linked' version if any of the values in the spreadsheet are changed. The purpose of the 'unlinked' versions was to send results via email without reference problems for cells that were linked to an external workbook.
