PRESIDING OFFICER'S RULING SCHEDULING
POSTAL SERVICE OFFICIALS FOR QUESTIONING

(Issued August 3, 2010)

On July 8, 2010, the Commission issued Order No. 485 in this docket which, among other things, scheduled public hearings for August 10-12, 2010.¹ The schedule for the appearance of Postal Service officials at those hearings is set forth below.

As previously ordered, hearings will begin at 9:30 a.m. and continue until cross-examination of scheduled witnesses has been completed. *Id.*

The Postal Service shall also identify a responsible official capable of responding to questions concerning its Flats Strategy and shall present that individual for questioning by the Commission at either the August 11 or August 12, 2010 hearing.

1. Postal Service officials are scheduled to appear at the August 10-12, 2010 hearings as set forth in the body of this ruling.
2. By close of business August 6, 2010, the Postal Service shall file a notice with the Commission identifying a responsible official capable of responding to questions regarding its Flats Strategy. That notice shall specify whether the designated official will be presented for questioning at the August 11 or August 12, 2010 hearing.
