**UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE MOTION FOR LATE ACCEPTANCE OF  
RESPONSE TO CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 2, QUESTION 29**  
(February 22, 2012)

The United States Postal Service moves for late acceptance of the filing today of its response to Question 29 of Chairman's Information Request No. 2. The response is 15 days late. The delay resulted from the need for (sometimes extensive) cross-functional coordination and review, and the press of PRC Docket No. N2012-1 and other equally important postal business. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but believes that any prejudice is minimal.
