3 **USPS-T-5 at 13, 17, and 19**

4 The updated library references supersede footnotes 1, 2 and 3 of USPS-
5 T-5, at pages 13, 17, and 19, respectively. Those footnotes describe my original
6 estimate of space utilized for operations other than mail processing at impacted
7 facilities and are now superseded because I have calculated the actual space
8 utilized for operations other than mail processing at impacted facilities instead of
9 using an estimate based on sampling. This set of updates is incorporated in
10 USPS Library Reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/80.

11 **USPS-T-5 at 18**

12 The estimate of \$68 million for xxxxxxxx at page 18 of USPS-T-5 is
13 superseded by an estimate of \$42 million. This revised update is consistent with
14 the new mail processing equipment sets described in USPS Library Reference
15 USPS-LR-N2012-1/83 and is reflected in USPS Library Reference USPS-LR-
16 N2012-1/81.

17 **USPS-LR-N2012-1/80**

18 USPS Library Reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/80 updates USPS Library
19 Reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/31. It reflects the new mail processing equipment
20 set described in USPS Library Reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/83 and derived

prepared by witness Rosenberg (USPS-T-3) in USPS Library Reference 37. Those initial equipment set estimates were based upon the assumption that all of the operational consolidation proposals pending on December 5, 2011 would be implemented. At my direction, her office has updated that library reference by producing USPS Library Reference 83 to reflect equipment set estimates based upon the February 23 facility consolidation decisions.

1 from the AMP study results released on February 23, 2012, calculation of the
2 actual space utilized for operations other than mail processing at impacted
3 facilities, and the maintenance cost attributable to cross-docking.

8 from the AMP study results released on February 23, 2012.

9 **USPS-LR-N2012-1/85**

10 Finally, USPS Library Reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/85 updates USPS
11 Library Reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/67. It reflects the new mail processing
12 equipment set described in USPS Library Reference USPS-LR-N2012-1/83.
13 This library reference support the revised estimates of equipment maintenance
14 staffing provided in USPS-LR-N2012-1/80.
