FIFTH NOTICE OF INTERNATIONAL MAIL DATA REQUIREMENTS
(Issued May 25, 1999)

To help the Commission prepare the report required by 39 U.S.C. Section 3663, on the costs, volumes, and revenues of the Postal Service's international mail services, the Service is requested to provide the following information on or before June 2, 1999. If any of the items listed below can be provided sooner, the Postal Service is requested to do so.

1. Please refer to the FY 1998 ICRA Report, page A-7. Please separate all the amounts shown for Direct Entry/Inbound between outbound mail (U.S. origin) and inbound mail (Foreign origin).
2. In the Postal Service's comments on Commission Order No. 1226, it stated at page 5 that Global Parcel Service is an inbound delivery service being tested with a limited number of foreign postal administrations. Please provide a more detailed description of this service.

It is ordered:

1. The Postal Service shall provide the information described in the body of this Order on or before June 2, 1999.

2. If any of the items of information cannot be provided by that time, the Postal Service shall provide a schedule of when those items can be provided.
