The United States Postal Service hereby provides a revised response to
interrogatory of the Office of the Consumer Advocate: OCA/USPS-T5-7,
redirected from witness Patelunas. The original response was filed on August 2,
1996.

The only change in the response is to subpart (e), reflecting that four sample
routes in the City Carrier Cost System were affected by attrition during FY 1995,
rather than nine as originally stated.


