UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE WITHDRAWAL OF  
NOTICE OF MOVE UPDATE THRESHOLD ADJUSTMENT PORTION OF  
MARKET DOMINANT PRICE CHANGES  
(December 22, 2010)

On December 10, 2010, the Commission issued an Order approving of the market dominant classification and price changes that the Postal Service filed notice of on November 2, 2010 in this docket. Order No. 606. The Commission indicated, however, that implementing the Move Update change that was included in the November 2 Notice would reduce the maximum allowable size of the next price increase by more than 0.6 percentage points. *Id.* at 3. The Postal Service therefore is withdrawing its notice of the Move Update change, and will not implement that change absent a subsequent filing with the Commission. The Postal Service does continue to plan implementation of the pricing incentives for First-Class Mail Automation Letters (Reply Rides Free) and Saturation and High Density Standard Mail, effective January 2, 2011.
