ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

(Issued December 16, 2011)

On October 6, 2011, Rick D. Lyles filed a petition with the Commission seeking review of the Postal Service's Final Determination to close the Campaign, Tennessee post office (Campaign post office).<sup>1</sup> On October 11, 2011, the Commission established Docket No. A2012-7 to consider the appeal, designated a Public Representative, and directed the Postal Service to file its Administrative Record and any responsive pleadings.<sup>2</sup>

On November 29, 2011, the Postal Service filed a notice stating its intent to withdraw the Final Determination to close the Campaign post office.<sup>3</sup> The Postal Service requests that this proceeding be dismissed. *Id.*

In light of the Postal Service's decision to withdraw the Final Determination to close the Campaign post office, the appeal is dismissed without prejudice. Docket No. A2012-7 is closed.

*It is ordered:*

1. The Petition for Review of the decision to close the Campaign, Tennessee post office is dismissed without prejudice.
2. Docket No. A2012-7 is closed.
