SCHEDULING ORDER ON AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION, AFL-CIO,  
MOTION FOR AN EMERGENCY ORDER

(Issued June 15, 2012)

On June 13, 2012, the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO (APWU), filed a Motion for an Emergency Order.<sup>1</sup> As part of its Emergency Motion, APWU asks the Commission to “require an expedited USPS response to this motion for emergency relief by June 20, 2012[.]” and requests a ruling on the Emergency Motion by June 30, 2012. *Id.* at 1.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 21(b), the Postal Service’s response to the Emergency Motion is due on June 20, 2012.
