PRESIDING OFFICER'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 1

(Issued June 30, 2017)

On September 26, 2011, the Commission issued an order adding the Inbound Market Dominant Express Service Agreement 1 (Agreement) to the market dominant product list.<sup>1</sup> The Postal Service recently filed a notice describing further updates concerning the Agreement.<sup>2</sup>

To assist the review of the Postal Service's filings, the Postal Service is requested to provide written responses to the following information request. The Postal Service's response should be provided as soon as possible, but no later than July 7, 2017.

1. Please confirm that the addition of an International Service Center to the Express Agreement allows the agreement to continue to improve the net financial position of the Postal Service in accordance with 39 U.S.C. § 3622(c)(10). If not confirmed, please explain and provide updated volume, revenue, and cost data.
