PUBLIC REPRESENTATIVE COMMENTS ON
POSTAL SERVICE NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
TO PRIORITY MAIL NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT

(November 20, 2017)

The Public Representative hereby provides comments pursuant to Notice Initiating Docket(s) for Recent Postal Service Negotiated Service Agreement Filings¹. In that Notice, the Commission established the above referenced docket to receive comments from interested persons, including the undersigned Public Representative, on a Postal Service Notice of a change in the terms of Priority Mail Contract 263². Attachment A to the Notice consists of a redacted version of the amendment to the original contract.

COMMENTS

Pursuant to 39 U.S.C. § 3633(a), the Postal Service's competitive prices must not result in the subsidization of competitive products by market dominant products; ensure that each competitive product will cover its attributable costs; and, ensure that all competitive products collectively contribute an appropriate share of the institutional costs of the Postal Service. The Public Representative has reviewed the original Priority Mail Contract 263, the Postal Service's amendment, and the financial work

papers associated with both. The amended contract appears to generate sufficient revenue to cover cost and meets the requirements of 39 U.S.C. § 3633(a). Therefore, the Public Representative recommends that the Commission approve, as amended, Priority Mail Contract 263.
