Postal Rate Commission (PRC)

RE: Order No. 4394 Ordering the US Postal Service to unseal the terminal dues aggregate data

Pretika Corporation would like to thank the PRC in its efforts to approve:

- The unsealing revenue information for products under the UPU umbrella
- The unsealing Inbound Letter Post revenue data by country group and shape

As a manufacturer/brand company member of the International Housewares Association (IHA) – which membership is comprised of leading manufacturers and brand companies in the Home and Housewares products industry, we would like to make the following statements:

- IHA agrees with the Commission that “because the data is aggregated, the Commission expected that the concerns that have typically caused disaggregated versions of the same data to be filed non-publicly would have been alleviated by the aggregation of data.”
- IHA also agrees that the postal justification for the disaggregated revenue data’s non-public status provided in the Application for Non-Public Treatment does not apply to the aggregated revenue data.
- IHA further encourages the Commission to request the Postal Service to produce and file publically Inbound Letter Post **volume** data by country group and shape.

By providing this information, the PRC will be making the right step forward in providing a level postal rate between domestic and international rates and a competitive market.
