In connection with the Commission's rules for Periodic Reports, 39 C.F.R. § 3050, I am submitting the following report today:

USPS Preliminary Financial Information (unaudited), September, 2018.¹

I have uploaded an electronic copy of this report to the Public Periodic Reports folder on the United States Postal Service Secure Large File Transfer Web Application portal (USPS SLFT).

The Postal Service acknowledges that two corrections to the Revenue, Pieces, and Weight report (RPW) have decreased the year-to-date International volume and revenue presented in this report compared to the August 2018 USPS Preliminary Financial Information (unaudited) report.² These changes are offset in other revenue, keeping total year-to-date revenue unchanged.

² First, the RPW improperly counted epacket volume as Priority Mail Express International. Second, revenue and volume from International Registered Mail was overstated by \$23.2 million, which was reallocated to Market Dominant Other revenue.
