SHIPPING SERVICES CONTRACT
BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE
AND

REGARDING
PRIORITY MAIL SERVICE

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service (“the Postal Service”) and  (“Customer”) entered into a Shipping Services Contract regarding PM Contract 463/Docket No. CP2018-290, regarding Priority Mail, on August 8, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the terms in Section I.H of the Contract.

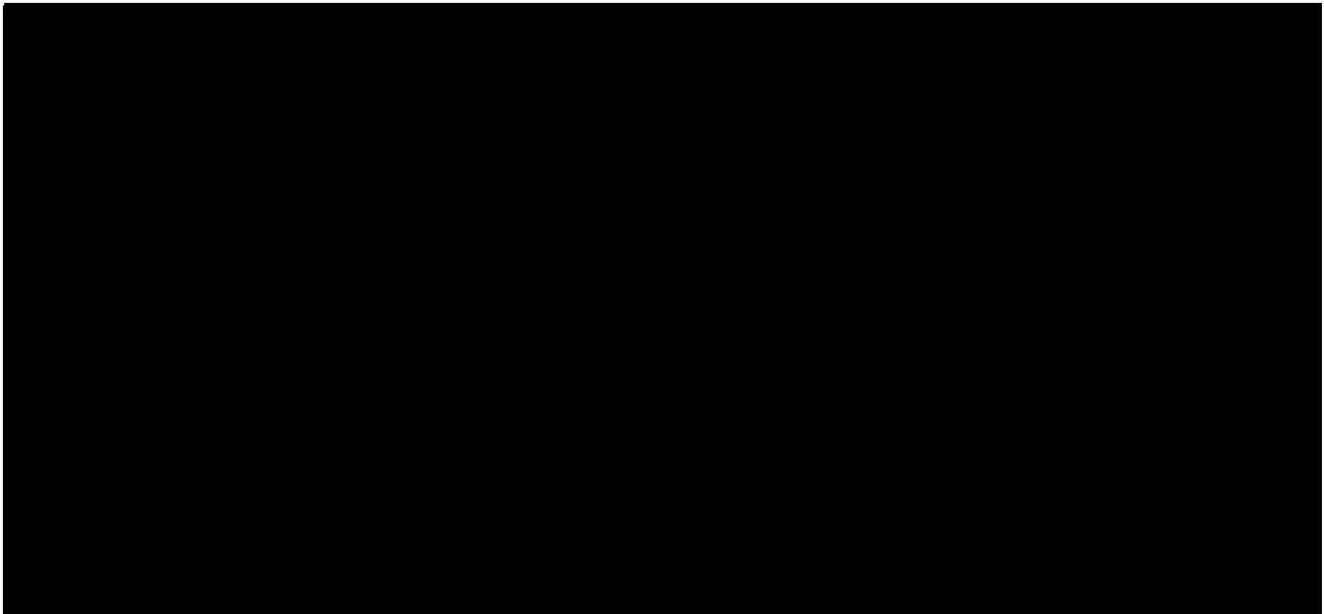
NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the contract is hereby amended as detailed below. The existing contract remains unchanged in all other respects. This amendment shall become effective two (2) business days following the day on which the Commission issues all necessary regulatory approval.

[Replace Section I.H, as follows. Table B and Table 1 shall remain unchanged, but are presented herein for the avoidance of doubt.]

I. Terms

- H. Contract Prices. Customer shall receive pricing based on Customer’s total number of Contract Packages shipped per Contract Quarter, as follows:
1. From the effective date of this Amendment until June 30, 2019, Customer shall pay Tier 3 prices pursuant to Table 1 below unless Customer exceeds the Tier 3 volume requirement during any Contract Quarter. Should Customer exceed the Tier 3 volume requirement for any full Contract Quarter through June 30, 2019, Customer will receive the corresponding higher tier price in the subsequent Contract Quarter.
 2. Subsequent Prices. Beginning July 1, 2019, Contract prices will be based on Customer’s volume of Contract Packages shipped during the previous full Contract Quarter, pursuant to Table B below.
 3. The Postal Service will monitor Customer’s volume of Contract Packages, and within fifteen (15) calendar days after the start of each Contract Quarter, will notify Customer of the applicable tier for that Contract Quarter based on Table B below, with corresponding prices found in Table 1 below. Tier price changes will be effective within fifteen (15) calendar days after the start of each

Contract Quarter. Discounted prices will be calculated by the Postal Service and rounded up to the nearest whole cent.
