MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR LATE  
ACCEPTANCE OF RESPONSE TO QUESTION 1  
OF CHAIRMAN'S INFORMATION REQUEST NO. 7

The United States Postal Service hereby moves for late acceptance of its response to the above-listed question of ChIR No. 7, issued on February 1, 2019. The ChIR No. 7 responses were due on Friday, February 8, 2019. By the due date, however, the Postal Service was in the midst of preparing to file ICRA revisions with major implications for the content of the response to this question. It would have been counterproductive to file a response then based on soon-to-be revised data. The ICRA revisions were filed yesterday, Monday February 11, and the response to Question 1 filed today addresses the revised data. The Postal Service regrets the delay, but submits that all concerned benefit from a response based on the best available data.
