The U.S. Chamber of Commerce (Chamber) writes to support the Postal Regulatory Commission's (Commission) preliminary decision to unseal the revenue data related to inbound letter postal shipments from foreign postal services, aggregated by shape and by terminal dues group. The Chamber has previously written to recommend this exact action be taken and is pleased that the Commission has moved to unseal this data.

As the Commission explained in its notice, the unsealing of this highly aggregated data is unlikely to result in commercial harm to the Postal Service. Further, the Commission has thoroughly outlined the importance of this level of transparency, particularly given the debate surrounding the United States publicly stated interest to spur reform within the Universal Postal Union.
