ORDER APPROVING MODIFICATION TWO TO GLOBAL RESELLER EXPEDITED
PACKAGE SERVICES 2 NEGOTIATED SERVICE AGREEMENT

(Issued May 15, 2019)

I. INTRODUCTION

The Postal Service seeks to modify a Global Reseller Expedited Package Services 2 negotiated service agreement.¹ For the reasons discussed below, the Commission approves the Modification.

In Order No. 4255, the Commission approved the Global Reseller Expedited Package Services 2 negotiated service agreement (Existing Agreement).² On May 14, 2019, the Postal Service filed notice that it has agreed to the Modification to the Existing Agreement.

II. COMMISSION ANALYSIS

The Commission has reviewed the Notice and the accompanying materials filed under seal.

Cost considerations. The Commission reviews competitive product prices to ensure that each product covers its attributable costs, does not cause market dominant products to subsidize competitive products, and contributes to the Postal Service's institutional costs. 39 U.S.C. § 3633(a); 39 C.F.R. §§ 3015.5 and 3015.7. As long as the revenue generated by the product exceeds its attributable costs, the product is unlikely to reduce the contribution of competitive products as a whole or to adversely affect the ability of competitive products as a whole to contribute an appropriate share of institutional costs. In other words, if a product covers its attributable costs, it is likely to comply with 39 U.S.C. § 3633(a).

The Existing Agreement is set to expire May 31, 2019.³ The Modification revises the expiration date of the contract to June 30, 2019. Notice at 1.

The Modification does not materially affect the underlying financial analysis of the Existing Agreement. Thus, the Commission finds that the Existing Agreement, as

modified, comports with the provisions applicable to rates for competitive products in 39 U.S.C. § 3633(a) and 39 C.F.R. § 3015.7.

Other considerations. The Existing Agreement, as modified, is set to expire June 30, 2019. *Id.*

If the Existing Agreement, as modified, is terminated prior to the scheduled expiration date, the Postal Service shall promptly notify the Commission.

In conclusion, the Commission approves the Existing Agreement, as modified.

III. ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

It is ordered:

1. The Commission approves the Global Reseller Expedited Package Services 2 negotiated service agreement, as modified.
2. The Postal Service shall notify the Commission if the Existing Agreement, as modified, terminates prior to the revised expiration date, June 30, 2019.
