The Postal Service has filed library references in this proceeding consisting of:

<b>USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP1</b>	<b>Domestic Price Comparisons (NONPUBLIC)</b>
<b>USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP2</b>	<b>Calculation of Average Zone (NONPUBLIC)</b>
<b>USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP3</b>	<b>Weight Step Data (NONPUBLIC)</b>
<b>USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP4</b>	<b>NSA Discount Calculation (NONPUBLIC)</b>

Each set of these workpapers has a Preface that explains the contents of the workpaper in further detail; these materials relate to the issues in this proceeding as follows:

USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP1 compares the proposed minimum and maximum inbound packet rates to the domestic equivalent rates under various scenarios.

USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP2 calculates the average zone for inbound E-format items, during FY 2019, Quarters 1 and 2.

USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP3 supports the weight step data calculations, and describes how these data are obtained.

USPS-LR-CP2019-155/NP4 calculates the average negotiated service agreement (NSA) discount based on FY 2019 Quarter 2 year-to-date revenue per piece averages.

Pursuant to 39 C.F.R. § 3001.31(b)(2)(ii)(B)-(C), these library references consist of voluminous and secondary data supporting the Notice of the United States Postal Service of Rates Not of General Applicability for Inbound E-format Letter Post, which the Postal Service has filed in this docket. The references include Category 3 & 6 material, and they were created using both previously published reference material and original material to which Postal Service finance, information technology, and operations staff provided material contributions.

These library references have been uploaded to the Non-Public Library References folder on the United States Postal Service Secure Large File Transfer Web Application portal (USPS SLFT). The materials include commercially sensitive information, such as price, volume, cost, and revenue data, certain non-published rates, negotiated contract data, and underlying calculations. The Postal Service incorporates by reference the application for non-public treatment, which is included as Attachment 1 to the Notice of the new rates that the Postal Service has filed in this docket.
