ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO RESPOND

(Issued September 6, 2019)

On August 30, 2019, the Public Representative filed reply comments in the above-captioned docket.<sup>1</sup> In portions of that filing the Public Representative responds to the substance of the Postal Service's reply comments, which amounts to an unauthorized surreply.<sup>2</sup>

On September 5, 2019, the Postal Service filed a motion requesting leave to respond to comments filed by the Public Representative.<sup>3</sup> The Postal Service also filed
