Hello,

I am writing in regards to the PRC's current review of the Forever stamp rate. I oppose the PRC's approval of the 55 cent Forever stamp, and I believe that the justification of "convenience" is absurd. If the rate increases merely followed inflation, the Forever stamp rate would be around 52 cents currently. Lots of postal prices are in increments other than 10s and 5s, and citing "convenience" as a reason to implement an unlawful 10% price increase is absurd. The PRC should reject the 55 cent price and lower it to a more reasonable, realistic amount.
