ORDER DISCONTINUING MONTHLY REPORTING REQUIREMENT

(Issued December 4, 2019)

In Order No. 4737 the Commission conditionally approved Amendment Three to Parcel Select Contract 20.¹ In that Order, the Commission required the Postal Service to report contract-specific volumes, costs, workhours, and other information on a monthly basis. Order No. 4737 at 8. The Commission imposed this requirement to permit the Commission to confirm that the Postal Service's financial models contained reasonable assumptions and accurately accounted for all costs associated with the changes made in the amendment. *Id.* at 6.

Since the issuance of Order No. 4737, the Postal Service has filed fifteen required monthly reports.² Having reviewed the reports, the Commission is satisfied that the current financial model contains reasonable assumptions and accurately accounts for the Postal Service's costs. Accordingly, the Commission discontinues the monthly reporting requirement. The Postal Service shall continue collecting data under its data collection plan as required by Order No. 4737, for review in the Commission's Annual Compliance Determination.

It is ordered:

1. The monthly reporting requirement described in Order No. 4737 is discontinued.
2. The Postal Service shall continue to collect data under the data collection plan required by Order No. 4737.
