ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR FILING OF APPENDICES

(Issued February 11, 2020)

On February 6, 2020, the Postal Service filed a motion requesting the Commission to file six appendices to reports accompanying Order No. 5337.¹ The Postal Service stated that access to the full range of materials underlying the two reports is necessary to evaluate and respond to initial comments and accompanying declarations that make technical arguments about the total factor productivity methodology. Motion at 1-2. It requested that the Commission either waive or shorten the 7 day motion response period.² The Commission issued an order shortening the

motion response period and directed that answers to the Motion were due by February 10, 2020.³

No answers were filed in response to the Motion. Because there is no objection to the Motion, the six appendices to the reports accompanying Order No. 5337 shall be filed under seal with this Order as Library Reference PRC-LR-RM2017-3-NP1. Any interested person seeking access to this library reference may file a motion for access to non-public materials under 39 C.F.R. § 3007.301.

It is ordered:

1. The Postal Service Motion for Filing of Appendices to Reports Filed with Order No. 5337, filed February 6, 2020, is granted.
2. The appendices to the reports accompanying Order No. 5337 are filed under seal with this order as Library Reference PRC-LR-RM2017-3-NP1.
